Setbacks:

300’ from a residence

100’ from a well (check wellhead protection areas)

Permit good for 6 months and 4 different legals

Storage of commercial livestock waste hauled to land where it is to be applied is limited to 6 months to receive and apply. Storage must be ¼ mile away from any residence.

For land not on DEQ manure management plan:

The owner of the land, upon which the application or disposal of commercial livestock waste is applied or disposed, shall be responsible for ensuring that the following minimum sanitation and odor practices are followed:

- a. There shall be no storage of livestock waste within a designated floodplain or floodway.
- b. Application shall be so controlled that soil or manure is not carried into any ditch, roadway or drainage area or onto a neighbor’s property.
- c. Livestock waste from concentrated pit buildings and/or buildings with outside lagoons only shall be directly injected into the soil, or with the approval of a Conditional Use Permit may be applied through irrigation systems.
- d. When injection of livestock waste from concentrated pit buildings and/or buildings with lagoons is impossible, due to frozen ground, an Administrative Conditional Use Permit is required to surface apply the waste.
- e. Storage of commercial livestock waste hauled to land where it is to be applied is limited to 6 months to receive and apply. Storage must be ¼ mile away from any residence.
