

## **HOWARD COUNTY COMMISSIONRS SPICIAL MEETING MINUTES**

April 5, 2022

A Special Meeting (single agenda item) of the Howard County Board of Commissioners was convened in open and public session on the 5<sup>th</sup> of April 2022, in the Boardroom, Howard County Courthouse, St. Paul, Nebraska.
