February 22, 2022

A meeting of the Howard County Board of Equalization was convened in open and public session on the 22nd day of February 2022, in the Boardroom, Howard County Courthouse, St Paul, Nebraska.

Notice of the meeting was given thereof on the 16th day of February 2022, a proof of publication filed in the Clerk's office. Copies of the agenda were posted in the Courthouse, mailed to each Commissioner, and kept current and available to the public at the Clerk's office.

Chairman Boehle called the meeting to order at 8:30 a.m. Roll Call: Dave Boehle, Aye; Kathy Hirschman; Aye Gary Rasmussen; Aye. Also Present is County Clerk Shawn Burkhardt, and County Assessor Neal Dethlefs, Absent is County Attorney Dave Schroeder. Chairman Boehle also stated to those in attendance that a current copy of the Nebraska Open meetings Act is available for review and indicated the location of such copy in the room where the meeting is being held.

Howard County Assessor Neal Dethlefs presented the permissive exemptions for 2022. A new location was added to the exemptions which is the American Legion Post # 119 building on Highway 281.
